Formation of Selection Committee – Call for Volunteers

At its meeting of 2nd December 2020, Session resolved to proceed to the formation of a Selection Committee as the next step towards calling a new Senior Pastor to Christlife Church. The Selection Committee will consist of up to eight (8) members, who will reflect the diversity of members in the Congregation (e.g. diversity of gender, age, how long a member of Christlife, etc.) Three (3) of the members will be elders.

Session invites expression of interest from congregation members who would like to volunteer to serve on the Selection Committee. Volunteers should be aware that the selection process may extend to a period of 12 months or more, based on the experience of other Presbyterian Charges.

Members may volunteer by submitting a written application to Lionel Johansen, Session Clerk, by hand or email lioneljohansen620@gmail.com on or before 10th January 2021. Applications should contain (i) the volunteer's name, (ii) a brief (2 or 3 sentences) indication of why they would like to serve on the Committee, and (iii) a brief (2 or 3 sentences) outline of past experience serving on selection panels, both in church and lay situations.

A Congregation Meeting will be held on 7th February 2021 where Session will seek the Congregation's endorsement of the composition of a proposed Selection Committee.
