*Give us this day our daily bread*

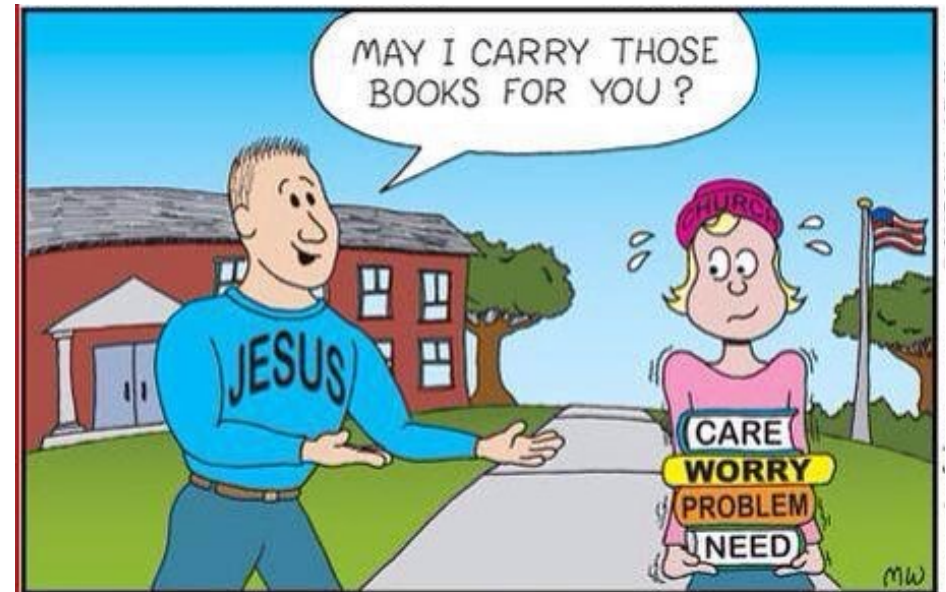
Lord hear our prayer for
