- For the Royal Family, as they grieve the loss of the Duke Edinburgh. Uphold the Queen during this time as she readjusts

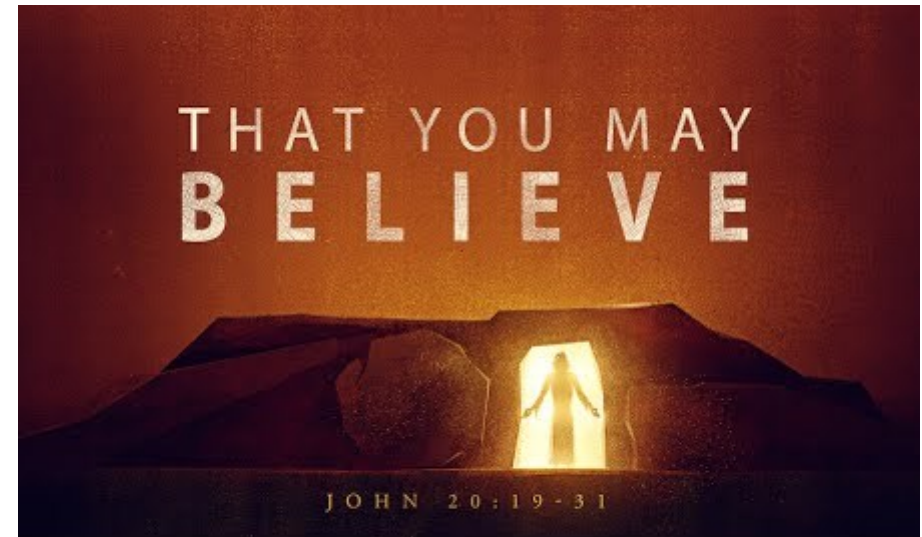
Kings Kids is in recess until Sunday 25 April. There is resource material available at the back of the church, along with books to read.
