When someone is exulted they are lifted up to a position where eyes are turned on them and words of praise are spoken about them.

When Paul was in prison he used the occasion to write letters to various churches. In all of them he urged the readers to hold fast to their faith in Christ. Paul's attitude was one of living for the praise of Jesus. His attitude was one of holding the spotlight on Jesus so that people would see how great He is for all who trust in Him.

Paul wrote those wonderful words: *"For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain."* (Philippians 1:21)

In other words, living each day as a Christian meant that Paul could keep on pointing people to Christ Jesus in his living, and in his death, Paul would receive all the benefits of salvation that Jesus gave in promise.

Our joy is to live for Jesus and to hold fast to the promises Jesus offers us in the Scriptures.

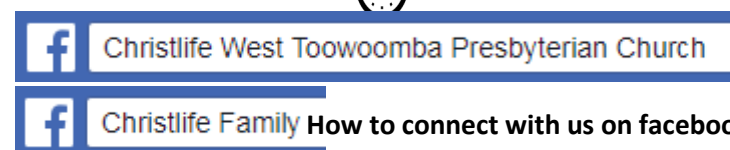
