Give us this day our daily bread

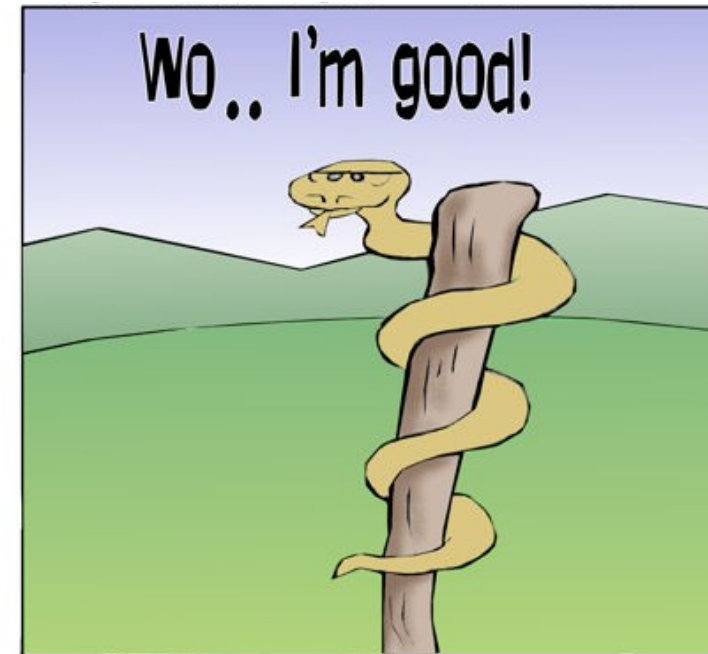
Lord hear our prayer for
