An Army document has been discovered instructing soldiers to punish and breakdown" ethnic-minorities, ie Christians and other civilians have been deemed to be against the military regime.

There are many Christians amongst both the Karen and the Kachin ethnic groups. The directives include special instructions to round up any dissenting civilian doctors and nurses and to report on any local leaders who are not fully cooperating with the military. Christian leaders in the region have requested prayer for the people of Myanmar and for a "change of heart" of army and coup leaders.


